CLOSURE DUE TO UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

Policy Statement

Box Pre School Playgroup will only close in the event of unavoidable circumstances, such as severe weather, flooding or staff illness.

Procedures

In the event of snow, the supervisor will carry out a risk assessment bearing in mind the safety of the children and staff and considering adult and child ratios.

In the event of staff sickness - the supervisor will contact all available bank staff but if are ratios cannot be met, we will close. If there is a case of a communicable disease we will take advice from the health protection agency and inform OFSTED. A deep clean of the premises will take place before we reopen.

In the event of closure due to flooding - after the building has dried out and been deep cleaned the supervisor will carry out a risk assessment before we reopen. OFSTED will be informed.

In all cases where we need to close unexpectedly we will email parents and post a news item on our face book group page.

Unfortunately, we are unable to issue refunds for unforeseen closures.

Closure due to the coronavirus pandemic

If we need to close the playgroup due to the coronavirus pandemic we will refund fees to parents. If children are self-isolating due to illness, refunds will not be given.
